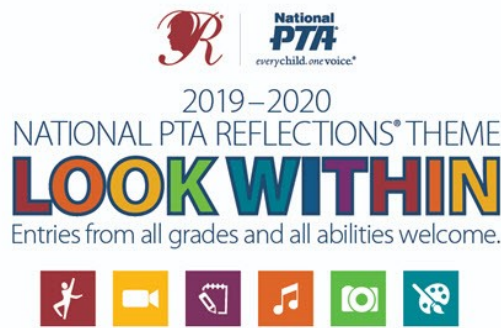


National, WA State and JHS Programs for Students

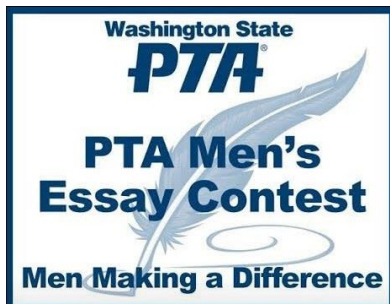
There are many great programs for students throughout the year from National PTA, WA State PTA and JHS PTSA. Program descriptions are listed below and more information will be shared on our website, Facebook page and included in our monthly Wolf Tracks Newsletter.



The purpose of the **Reflections** program is to provide an opportunity for students to use their creative talents by expressing themselves through their own original works.

A student may submit an entry in any of six arts areas. Only original works of art are accepted. The six art areas are: Visual Arts Photography, Literature, Music Composition, Dance Choreography, and Film Production.

Entries are due in early November.



This statewide **Men's Essay Contest** explores the important and varied contributions that men make in the lives and education of children – from the children's perspective. All men involved in a child's life – fathers, uncles, grandfathers, brothers, step-fathers, mentors, neighbors, pastors, coaches, and friends – impact the children they care about. Research clearly shows that male involvement positively influences academic success at all levels of schooling – preschool through college. When male figures are involved with students' schooling, they enjoy school more and perform better in and out of school. The application deadline is March 1st each year.

WSPTA // Game Development Competition

The purpose of this program is to provide an opportunity for students, either individually or in teams of up to six members, to use their creative talents and express themselves by developing a computer game. Students' submissions are judged in the following areas: game of the year, arts and animation, game design, programming (code), and audio design. We will share the theme when it is announced.

Students in grades 9-12 may participate individually or in teams. Students in 7th or 8th grade may compete with a team of 9th-12th grade students. Teams are encouraged and may have up to 6 members and may be composed of multiple grades. A PTA may have an unlimited number of teams.

You must sign up in January and completed entries are due March 1st.

WA State PTA—Scholarship Program

Washington State PTA offers scholarships to graduating seniors from Washington state public high schools with an active PTA, who will be starting college (either two-year or four-year) in the fall. Applications are due March 1st and scholarships are awarded by April 30th.

JHS PTSA—Senior Scholarship Program

The JHS PTSA strives to promote the education and welfare of our students by sponsoring school programs and events. One way in which we can directly impact our students is through our Senior Scholarship Award program which recognizes the Timberwolf seniors who exemplify excellence in academics, school pride and involvement at JHS. Applications are due in mid-April.
